Twelvestone Health Partners announces expansion, new jobs

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. (WKRN) –Governor Bill Haslam, along with other officials, announced TwelveStone Health Partners plans to build a new corporate headquarters that will expand its Murfreesboro operations.

The headquarters will consolidate the company's corporate, logistics, billing and service divisions.

TwelveStone, formerly Reeves-Sain Family of Medical Services, will invest \$14.9 million and create 200 new jobs.

"The momentum of Tennessee's healthcare industry is strengthened not only when companies locate in our state, but also when they decide to expand and grow here. We congratulate TwelveStone on today's announcement and thank the company for bringing us one step closer toward making Tennessee the No. 1 location in the Southeast for high quality jobs," Haslam said.

TwelveStone will begin construction in mid-March on a new 30,000 square foot corporate headquarters at Heritage Square in Murfreesboro providing the company with a centralized space for business operations as well as warehouse space.
