TwelveStone names CFO

Former exec returns after stint at Symphony

Medical supplies and services company TwelveStone Health Partners has brought back the CFO of its predecessor after he helped right the financial ship at the Nashville Symphony.

Chad Boyd had been the top financial officer at the Reeves-Sain Family of Medical Services before being recruited to work alongside KraftCPAs' Kevin Crumbo on the turnaround of the Symphony, which in 2014 narrowly avoided a bankruptcy filing and foreclosure sale of the Schermerhorn Symphony Center.

Reeves-Sain last year sold its specialty pharmacy and retail businesses for \$66 million to discount retailer Fred's Inc.. TwelveStone was relaunched earlier this year to focus on medical equipment and pharmacy services.

"Chad may be the only chief financial officer I know who is also a skilled portrait painter," says Shane Reeves, president and CEO of TwelveStone, which plans to hire 200 for its new Murfreesboro home office. "The eye for detail required of portrait painters is a skill that makes for a great financial leader. I'll be relying on he and his team to help expand and maintain profitability in our expansion into all 95 Tennessee counties."
